The objective is to support dissemination and adoption of knowledge in innovative food safety practices particularly for end-users. The Swiss - Ukraine partners will focus on improving food safety and sustainability in traditional cheese making.

ProCheese gives online and offline education for professionals through its Academy, provides the necessary cheese equipment, promotes Ukrainian cheese at the World Cheese Awards (bringing 13 medals in 2022), offers cheese customizing of showcases, and organizes cheese events.

ProCheese prepares a special competence base for artisan cheeses in Ukraine and helps Ukrainian cheese makers achieve international quality standards.
